 - 13 have been submitted to the Agencies
 - 13 have USEPA and Illinois EPA concurrence and are final
- AF proposed 15 sites for No Further Action (NFA)
 - Agencies concurred with NFA for 15 sites based on review of the RI reports, and an NFA Record of Decision is signed by all Agencies for all 9 sites
- 17 sites will proceed to Feasibility Studies (FSs)
 - 2 FSs have been submitted to the agencies for 7 sites

Operable Unit 2

- 12 RI reports will be completed
 - 11 have been submitted to the agencies

 - 4 are still in coordination with Illinois EPA and USEPA


Treatability Study

- Treatability studies were performed to evaluate the effectiveness of reductive dechlorination and chemical oxidation in reducing contamination in soil and groundwater at the former Chanute AFB.
- Since the last RAB an additional post-treatment sampling round was completed
- The data will be used by the Performance Based Cleanup contractor in the Feasibility Study process to identify the best cleanup method for sites throughout the base.

Corrective Action Plan Implementation at Buildings 1, 711, and 933





1 annual report to Congress is a report that the Air
 2 Force Real Property Agency publishes and all of the
 3 closed bases, the information is in there,
 4 financial information and those kinds of things.
 5 There's a little bit of a narrative and then
 6 there's a lot of summary numbers. So for folks
 7 that are interested in looking those things up,
 8 those sites will probably be helpful to you.

9 The last published version of the
 10 ARC, as we refer to it, is from 2006. I believe
 11 the 2007 will be posted in the near future but
 12 right now those are the last numbers that have been
 13 published. And the appendix -- and if -- this is a
 14 big document, thousands of pages. So what you're
 15 looking for, if you want to look up information on
 16 the former Chanute Air Force Base, is actually in
 17 Appendix M of that document where you'll find all
 18 of the BRAC bases and they're in alphabetical
 19 order. And it's a one-pager. So rather than
 20 printing, you know, 2,000 sheets of paper, find
 21 Chanute, hit print just on that one page and you
 22 can get all the information you're looking for that
 23 we've got out there on that.

1 Okay. Well, that ends my piece of
 2 this and I'm going to kick this over to Paul. Just
 3 a warning, I'm walking around with a sign-in sheet,
 4 so if you didn't sign in I'm going to ask you to
 5 please give us your name and a little bit of
 6 contact information. And so I'll be doing that
 7 while Paul's giving you his presentation. Thank
 8 you.

9 MR. CARROLL: Good afternoon. I'm
 10 Paul Carroll, the environmental coordinator for
 11 Chanute, for the Air Force. As we do every RAB we
 12 try to give you all an environmental update, what
 13 progress that we've made and outlook of future work
 14 that we have.

15 In OU-1, which is the northwestern
 16 portion of the base, excluding the portion where
 17 the landfills are and southeastern portion, there
 18 are 13 remedial investigation reports that we had
 19 initially started and have completed all of those
 20 reports. All those have been submitted and we have
 21 concurrence on all of these. So we're complete
 22 with the investigation phase of the OU-1 area. We
 23 had proposed 15 sites for no further action in that

1 OU-1 area and we've already -- we have gotten
 2 concurrence for no further action for nine of those
 3 sites based on the reports. And no further action
 4 record of decision for all of those sites has been
 5 signed.

6 Seventeen of the sites that we
 7 investigated in OU-1 will proceed to feasibility
 8 studies which are studies to determine the most
 9 appropriate method of clean-up that we need to do
 10 to those sites. Anything that goes to feasibility
 11 study is going have to be cleaned up to some
 12 extent.

13 In OU-1, the southeastern portion of
 14 the base where the landfills are, 12 RI reports
 15 were planned to be completed, those cover 24 some
 16 odd sites, in that area. Eleven of them have been
 17 submitted to the agencies and of those we have six
 18 that have been -- that have EPA and Illinois EPA
 19 concurrence, those have gone final. One of those
 20 had Illinois EPA concurrence only and that's gone
 21 final too. That's the FTA-1 site where we've
 22 briefed you all on previous RABs. It's right in
 23 that area. And four RI reports are still in

1 coordination with EPA and Illinois EPA. Meaning
 2 that we've submitted the reports, we've been
 3 talking about -- EPA and Illinois EPA have given us
 4 comments and we've been negotiating finalizing
 5 those documents. We're pretty close. We talked
 6 this morning again and we're getting pretty close
 7 to finalizing those documents.

8 Eighteen sites in OU-2 will proceed
 9 to feasibility studies, will require some sort of
 10 clean-up. Okay.

11 In OU-2 we've done two no further
 12 action records of decision addressing four sites
 13 and those have been routed for signature. As of
 14 this morning EPA has signed the Heritage Lake ROD
 15 including three sites. So we have Air Force and
 16 EPA signature on both of those RODs and I gave
 17 those this morning to Chris Hill and he's taking
 18 them to his management for signature.

19 The Fire Training Area 1 Record of
 20 Decision, our director has signed that and EPA has
 21 told us that they won't sign it so we're going to
 22 just send that to Illinois EPA for signature.

1 treatability study that we've been doing. We
 2 started almost a year ago to determine whether
 3 certain degradation injections into the
 4 contaminated groundwater will work to degrade the
 5 TCE and the less harmful byproducts. We have done
 6 four rounds of sampling to look at the
 7 effectiveness of that and then -- we're right now
 8 we're -- I guess about two weeks ago we did a fifth
 9 round of sampling to get what -- was it, almost
 10 about 300 days?

11 DR. BLAKE: Yes.
 12 MR. CARROLL: Getting close to a
 13 year, final round of data to kind of evaluate
 14 whether that -- those treatments have been
 15 effective or showing promise for effectiveness.
 16 And we'll use that data in the feasibility studies
 17 to help determine the most appropriate method of
 18 clean-up.

19 The sites that we used on that were
 20 Fire Training Area 2 where the big huge fire
 21 training area was. We did remove the soil and took
 22 it to a lab and did bench scale treatability
 23 studies with that site. And then the other sites

1 were Building 914, concrete tanks, oil water
 2 separator, and Building 927. They were -- some of
 3 the bigger TCE plumes are from those sites in OU-2.
 4 So we did an insight -- in situ, is what it's
 5 called, injection of hydrogen reducing compound in
 6 that area.

7 And the other actions that we've been
 8 doing are corrective actions for some petroleum
 9 storage tanks and oil water separators. Building 1
 10 aboveground storage tanks, we did a removal action
 11 at that site. Do we have pictures of that? Those
 12 were from the last time.

13 DR. BLAKE: Nope.

14 MR. CARROLL: We have completed the
 15 work at Building 1. Building 711 we did some
 16 contaminated soil removal there and Building 933 we
 17 removed a small -- very small oil water separator
 18 that's probably two feet in diameter at that
 19 location. All of that work's done. We've
 20 completed the completion reports and submitted
 21 those to Illinois EPA and they're in the process of
 22 reviewing those right now.

1 We're going to complete all the remaining Remedial
 2 Investigation reports in OU-2 with the exception of
 3 the Landfill 4 RI report. And we're going to
 4 prepare proposed plans and no further action RODs
 5 for three sites in OU-1 and three sites in OU-2
 6 that we anticipate going to no further action.
 7 That will happen beginning this spring and summer.
 8 And we have a corrective action plan for Building
 9 710 for implementation of -- well, installation of
 10 a groundwater monitoring well and some groundwater
 11 monitoring.

12 And we'll continue to operate,
 13 maintain, monitor the landfills, the three
 14 landfills that we have on the base. Those require
 15 ongoing maintenance, ongoing monitoring, and make
 16 sure the caps still have good integrity, haven't --
 17 no ditches, things like that. And then we're going
 18 to pick back up the project of backfilling the
 19 northern excavation area, the pond just south of
 20 Heritage Lake, we've got a project to complete that
 21 work this summer also.

1 700 and that's also a petroleum storage tank that
 2 we have -- that's the one we have the monitoring
 3 well. Monitoring well and we're going to be
